We're are all finding it difficult at the moment with the rising cost of living and rocketing energy prices - but some more than others. Warsop Parish council are working to provide Hygiene packs to those most in need, with the support of our councillors, local organisations, schools and hopefully the generosity of some of our local people who are fortunate enough to be in a position to help others – no matter how small the donation. We are looking to create hygiene packs which can be easily accessible to those who cannot prioritise hygiene over heating or eating and subsequently go without essential day to day products.

CAN YOU HELP?

The packs will be catagorised into MALE, FEMALE & INFANT/BABY
They will include the following items –

MALE HYGIENE PACK

Shampoo, conditioner, shower gel, shaving cream, shavers, soap, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, hair comb, nail clippers and nail scrubbers.

FEMALE HYGIENE PACK

Shampoo, conditioner, shower gel, shavers, deodorant, face wipes, sanitary products, toothbrush, toothpaste,hair brush and nail clippers.

INFANT/BABY

Younger years - shampoo, body wash, baby oil, toothpaste, toothbrush, nappies, wipes, rash cream, and talc powder.

As well as these we want to supply laundry products too – Wash powder etc.

All unopened and in date donations are welcome, so if you are in a position to help others please do - just one item will help ease the embarrassment of hygiene poverty for someone who's in need.
