Good OFSTED outcome, October 2017

As you will be aware, Meden was recently inspected by Her Majesty's Inspector of schools (OFSTED). This inspection was carried out under Section 8 of the Education Act 2005.

I am pleased to be able to confirm the outcome of the visit. The visit was the first short inspection to be carried out, since the school was judged to be good in May 2014.
