

How we deal with bullying at Meden



Report

If you are being bullied, or see bullying happening, tell a member of staff straight away or email the bullying email address from your school account



Investigate

An investigation takes place and statements are taken from at least three people:

THE VICTIM
THE PERPETRATOR
THE WITNESS



Resolve

Restorative justice completed, a sanction put in place and recorded on the bullying log

What is bullying?



Physical

Hitting, kicking, slapping, pinching, spitting, tripping, pushing, blocking

Stealing or destroying someone's possessions

Making mean or rude hand gestures

Touching in unwanted and inappropriate ways



Verbal

Name-calling

Insults

Teasing

Intimidation

Homophobic or racist remarks

Inappropriate sexual comments

Taunting

Threatening to cause harm



Social

Lying and spreading rumours

Leaving someone out on purpose

Telling others not to be friends with someone

Embarrassing someone in public

Damaging someone's social reputation or relationships



Cyber

Posting/sending hurtful texts, emails, posts, images or videos

Making online threats

Intimidating others online using their log-in

Deliberately excluding others online

Spreading nasty gossip or rumours online
