12 days of Christmas Attendance Challenge

Dear Parents/Carers,

You may remember that at the end of last half term we launched our 14 day Attendance Challenge. The challenge was a great success with **over 50% of our students achieving 100% in the final 3 weeks of term**, over 200 of these students had not achieved 100% attendance in the 5 weeks leading up to the challenge.

On the back of this success, we are launching our **12 day of Christmas Attendance Challenge**. Students will once again receive a booklet as before with the aim of achieving 100% attendance for the rest of term..



From Thursday 28th November up until the last day of term on 13th December, they will have the opportunity to complete their card with a tutorial sticker simply by attending each day.

On the last day of term, all students who have succeeded in attending 100% of the time and completing their card in full, will be entered in to a prize draw. There are 12 prizes to be won. As students names are drawn at random they will get the opportunity to choose one of the 12 available prizes, until they are all gone. Students have received the information in tutorial this week.

Please encourage your child to take part in the challenge. School attendance has such a huge impact on a student's social and mental welfare as well as academic achievements and we want to ensure we are working with you to ensure that each child is attending as much as possible.
