This morning all staff attempted to make the journey to work as usual and at 7am when we make the decision it appeared that the school would be open as usual. Unfortunately, staff traveling in from Derbyshire and South Yorkshire were met with treacherous road conditions and were unable to complete their journeys. This meant that we had to make a late decision to close to school because the site would not be adequately staffed to provide safe levels of supervision for your children.

Given the forecast weather over the next couple of days we will have to make a decision each morning as to whether or not the school will open. We will text parents as soon as possible each morning if the school will be closed. Please assume that the school will be open unless you receive a text.
