Dear Parent/Carer,

As we approach the Easter holiday, I wanted to take the opportunity to remind you of our uniform expectations to provide you time to fully prepare for returning on the 19th of April.

Whilst it is clear our students take great pride in their appearance in school, please can you support us by ensuring your child is school ready, when they arrive on the first day, by being in full and complete uniform.

As a polite reminder students should be wearing

- a **white school shirt**,
- a **blue striped tie**, the same as the one above,
- and the **Meden School blazer**.

Students should also wear

- **black school trousers**,
- or a **black knee length skirt**, similar to the one shown above.

If your child would like to wear a jumper, it must be a **BLACK V-NECK** jumper, as shown above.

Each year group has its own-coloured lanyard, and this must be **worn at all times**.

Finally, students must wear **black leather school shoes**. Shown above (No trainers)

If there are any issues with obtaining uniform, or a medical reason your child cannot wear the correct uniform please contact Miss. Hibbert in Student Services and she will offer support where we can.

Students are only allowed one pair of stud earrings. Ear bars and similar piercings are **not** part of our uniform and staff will use the Expectation Card to highlight this.

During the holiday some students may decide to apply false nails. While they are suitable for a school holiday, they are **not** part of our school uniform due to health and safety reasons and practicality. I

if your child has applied false nails during the holiday, please can you ensure that they are **removed for the first day**, so your child is school ready.



As the weather changes students are also starting to wear hoodies and round neck jumpers. I would like to remind you that **hoodies and round neck jumpers are not school uniform**. If a student wears them to school, they must place them in their school bag when they arrive in school and only put them on when they leave school site.

It is important to us that all our students are ready and prepared to learn.

We supply all students with the basic equipment they need to engage in our lessons free of charge. Students are given a full set of equipment at the start of the term and can resupply as needed. To support this please can you ensure that you child has a **school bag** where they can keep their equipment. If you need support with getting a school bag, please let Miss.
