

As Christmas fast approaches, I wanted to confirm the arrangements for the last day of term. **Friday 13**th **will now be a non-uniform day**, including Christmas jumpers and Christmas themed clothing. As with all non-uniform days, we remind you that the following clothing is unsuitable for school and as such should not be worn on a non-uniform day at any time.

Examples of suitable items to donate are items such as cereals, soup, dried pasta, dried rice, tinned meat, tinned vegetables, tea/coffee, biscuits, UHT milk, toiletries, hygiene products, nappies, wipes etc. Where possible, please send your items with your child as our Meden College students will be collecting from tutorials.

Furthermore, we plan to close school at 12:50pm on the last day. Students will still have the option to purchase and eat lunch in school before they leave for the day. The Meden school bus services (MEDEN1 & MEDEN2) have been reviewed and the times for these have been amended for that day.
