# The purpose of this evening

# Leading up to September

## On results day

- Students will find out whether they meet the entry requirements for Meden College
- Students have been offered their place already but have to **register**. There will be a link on the website as well as a handout on results day.
- Formalise subject choice – 3 subjects (can trial 4 in the first couple of weeks if undecided)



# What to expect on the first day

- Come through reception and go straight to college. You will spend the morning with your tutor group.
- Photographs will be taken on the first day for your ID card. This will be given out during the 2<sup>nd</sup> week
- Bring equipment – lessons start p3 after break



# Structure of the school day

- Tutorial in the morning – 25 minutes

- Tuesday – 8.50am – 4pm
- Friday – 8.50am – 2.20pm
