Dear Parent/ Carers,

We are continually looking to maintain high standards in everything we do at Meden School and uniform and being prepared for school are a key part of this.

Ahead of the half term break, and leading into our final term, our expectations remain unchanged. **All students must be in the correct uniform each and every day.**

The Meden School uniform consists of the following:

- Meden blazer,
- Meden tie,
- white formal shirt,
- black school trousers,
- black formal school shoes
- optional black v-neck jumper,
- Lanyards must be worn at all times.
- Jewellery is limited to a single stud earring in each ear.
- Hair colour should be natural
- Subtle make up is permitted Y10/Y11. Students will be asked to remove any make up that is judged to be unsuitable or that does not adhere to these guidelines.

Please be advised that on our return after half term, we will be ensuring that all students are wearing correct uniform as they enter the building. Any students who are not in full and correct uniform will not be permitted to enter into the main school site until their uniform has been addressed. We will supply items where needed, if we have them, or we will contact you to bring their correct uniform to school. Where convenient, we will arrange to send the student home to get changed, and then return to school. Items of jewellery that are not permitted will need to be removed & will be kept safe until the end of the school day.



### **ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED**

Can I please stress that the following items **do not adhere to our uniform standards and should not be worn.**

- hoodies and other sweatshirts,
- leggings,
- trainers (which includes all black 'Air Force Ones'),
- multiple earrings,
- nose piercings & other items of jewellery should not be worn.
- False or acrylic nails

If for any reason, you have difficulty with uniform or there are issues on any particular day, please contact the school. Likewise, please keep us informed of any medical concerns that will affect your child.
