As we approach the end of term we are going to conduct a full uniform check on Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> May. Whilst it is clear our students take great pride in their appearance in school, please can you support us by ensuring your child is school ready by being in full and complete uniform.

As a polite reminder students should be wearing a white school shirt, a blue striped tie, the same as the one above, and the Meden School blazer. Students should also wear black school trousers, or a black knee length skirt, similar to the one shown above. If your child would like to wear a jumper, it must be a black v-neck jumper, as shown above.

Each year group has its own lanyard and this must be worn at all times. Finally, students must wear black leather school shoes. If students are not in shoes a school pair will be provided. Some students have told us they can't wear their school shoes because of blisters, to assist with this we now have a supply of blister plasters and these will be provided on Tuesday where needed, If there are any issues with obtaining uniform, or a medical reason your child cannot wear the correct uniform please contact Miss. Students are only allowed one pair of stud earrings. Ear bars and similar piercings are not part of our uniform. Nose studs are also not part of our school uniform. If your child has applied false nails, please can you ensure that they are removed by Tuesday, so your child is school ready.



In colder weather students are also starting to wear hoodies and round neck jumpers. I would like to remind you that hoodies and round neck jumpers are not school uniform. If a student wears them to school, they must place them in their school bag when they arrive in school and only put them on when they leave school site.

It is important to us that all our students are ready and prepared to learn. We supply all students with the basic equipment they need to engage in our lessons free of charge. Students are given a full set of equipment at the start of the term and can resupply as needed. To support this please can you ensure that you child has a school bag where they can keep their equipment. If you need support with getting a school bag please ley Miss. Hibbert know and we will do what we can to help you.
