TRANSITION PORTAL

This section of the website contains all the information you will need about the day to day running of the school along with videos and tasks to give your child an insight into typical school life.

IMPORTANT NEXT STEPS

In order to ensure we have the correct information for your child and officially enrol them, we need you to access your parent portal which has been set up for you. This will allow you to update and add important information for your child. There are some very helpful sizing guides to help you measure your child to determine which size to order. The uniform company will be coming into school on **Tuesday 9th July between 3pm and 5:00pm** to offer advice about sizing and how to order uniform.

If you would like to come along to this session, you do not need an appointment, just come to the HOUSE just off Burns Lane between these times (there will be a sign). Please note that this is the only session available and uniform can not be purchased on the day.

TRANSITION DAYS

Our transition days this year will take place on **Monday 1st and Tuesday 2nd July** with a **Parents Evening on the Tuesday from 6pm until 7pm approx**. We have already informed your child 's primary school of these details, but you should also mention it to ensure they are aware that your child will be at Meden School on those days.

On transition day, students must arrive **BEFORE 8:45am** and make their way to the main quad area (there will be plenty of staff on hand to help) We will ask them to line up in their tutorial groups so please ensure they know which group they are in.

On **Monday** students should come in their normal **primary PE kit** and bring a **packed lunch**. We will ask primaries for a list of FSM children and lunch will be provided for these children.

On **Tuesday** students are asked to come in their **primary uniform** and we will be providing a **lunch free of charge** in our canteen. If your child has any allergies then please let us know on <u>office@medenschool.co.uk</u>. They can choose to bring a packed lunch if they prefer.

Students should bring a refillable water bottle that can be fill in the dining areas with cold filtered water.

With regards to the MEDEN1 & MEDEN2 buses. If your child has a sibling who already has a pass for this service then we are happy for them to travel with older siblings, otherwise if would be preferable for you to make your own arrangements to get students to and from Meden on those transition days.
