Work/skills/activities being covered in lesson leading to exams	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Week 1 Focus within lesson on finishing theme E- Religion, Crime and Punishment. Applying knowledge to exam questions and ensuring students keep developing their timings and exam skill. Homework based on key Islamic words. • Week 2 Focus within lesson on finishing theme E- Religion, Crime and Punishment. Applying knowledge to exam questions and ensuring students keep developing their timings and exam skill. Students will have an end of topic mock exam. Homework based on Key Christian words. • Week 3 Preparing for end of topic assessment. Going over revision tools including 'brain dumps', revision cards and practice exam questions linked to the topic. Homework: Revision for the mock exam. • Week 4 Students will receive a master copy of all previous exam questions. Students will RAG rate questions based on their understanding. Focus within lesson on exam questions and how students can navigate past tricky questions to ensure maximum marks. Homework: Students to choose either two 4,5 markers or one 12 marker they have RAG rated red or yellow and answer it. • Week 5 Focus on retrieval of paper 1 Islam and Christianity. Focus within lesson on exam questions including 4, 5 and 12 markers. Help students to navigate past tricky questions to ensure maximum marks. Homework: Students to choose either two 4,5 markers or one 12 marker they have RAG rated red or yellow and answer it.

Focus within lesson on exam questions and how students can navigate past tricky questions to ensure maximum marks. Homework: 12 Marker focus • Week 7 Focus on retrieval of paper 2 and the themes. Students develop their application to exam style questions independently and becoming expert examiners by understanding mark schemes and improving their work. Homework: 4- and 5-mark focus • Week 8 Students to apply knowledge to questions and instant feedback provided to improve on their answers. Students will have a bank of answers to revise from. Homework: Paper 2 exam questions. • Week 9 Students to apply knowledge to questions and instant feedback provided to improve on their answers. Students will have a bank of answers to revise from. Homework: Paper 1 exam questions. • Week 10 Targeted intervention and warm-ups prior to exam
