



# YEAR 7 HOME LEARNING

Homework is given as part of a 3 week cycle

1. Week 1 – create flashcards
2. Week 2 – look, say, cover, write check (using the flashcards created in week 1)
3. Week 3 – Brain dump - a check to see how much you have learned

On week 1 of every cycle, you will be emailed the work to learn which are usually key words for that subject. We will also upload them to the website (Homework) and to MCAS under Important Documents. The point of the homework is to teach students how to revise effectively and to build up key vocabulary for each of their core subjects.

Here is the work per subject for this 3 week cycle

## **ENGLISH – Learn the following key words**

<b>Morality</b>	Knowing the difference between right and wrong
<b>Hubris</b>	Having excessive pride or self-confidence
<b>Protagonist/ antagonist</b>	The leading character in a play, film, or novel

## **SCIENCE – Learn the following key words**

<b>Independent variable</b>	The variable in an experiment that is changed.
<b>Dependent variable</b>	The variable in an experiment that is measured.
<b>Control variable</b>	The variable in an experiment that is kept the same.

## **GEOGRAPHY – Learn the following key words**

<b>Continent</b>	An area of land made up of different countries
<b>Ocean</b>	A large area of sea (saltwater)
<b>Country</b>	An area of land with its own government

## **HISTORY – Learn the following key words**

<b>Papal</b>	Relating to a <u>Pope</u>
<b>Fyrd</b>	Untrained soldier who is normally a farmer.
<b>Housecarls</b>	A member of the <u>bodyguard</u> of a Danish or English king or noble
