The point of the homework is to teach students how to revise effectively and to build up key vocabulary for each of their core subjects.

ENGLISH – Learn the following key words

Archetypal hero	A character who overcomes obstacles and achieves their goals
Omnipotence	Having unlimited or very great power
Omniscience	The state of knowing everything

<u>SCIENCE – Learn the following key words</u>

Compound	Made from two or more elements which are chemically combined.
Mixture	Two or more elements or compounds not chemically combined.
Distillation	Method used to separate a mixture using evaporation and condensation.



MATHS – Learn the following key words

Adding and subtracting negative numbers	Examples: 4 + -2 = 4 - 2 = 2 53 = 5 + 3 = 8 <u>https://youtu.be/mED76j4Agiw</u>
Credit/Debit/Profit/ Loss	Credit – Increase in money shown in account Debit – Decrease of money shown in account Profit – Income minus the expenses Loss – When cost price is less than the selling price

Grid references	A way to locate places on a map
Scale	The ratio between distance on a map and distance in real life

Motte	Defensive mound of earth.
Palisade	Wooden fence around the Bailey.
