Homework is given as part of a 3 week cycle

1. Week 1 – create flashcards
2. Week 2 – look, say, cover, write check (using the flashcards created in week 1)
3. Week 3 – Brain dump - a check to see how much you have learned

On week 1 of every cycle, you will be emailed the work to learn which are usually key words for that subject. We will also upload them to the website (Homework) and to MCAS under Important Documents. The point of the homework is to teach students how to revise effectively and to build up key vocabulary for each of their core subjects.

ENGLISH – Learn the following key words

Poetry	Power	The ability to direct or influence the behaviour of others
	Imagery	Visual, descriptive or figurative language
	Extended metaphor	A metaphor extends over the course of multiple lines, sentences, or paragraphs

SCIENCE – Learn the following key words

Practical Vocab	pH scale	Way to measure whether a solution is acidic or alkaline.
	Indicator	Chemical that changes colour depending on if a substance is acidic or alkaline.
	Neutralisation	Reaction between acids and alkalis that produce neutral substances.

MATHS – Learn the following key words

Multiplying & dividing	Product of prime factors	We can take any positive number and write it as a series of prime numbers being multiplied. https://youtu.be/veILCLvH198
	HCF/LCM	HCF - Highest Common Factor LCM – Lowest Common Multiple
	Mean	A type of average. Method: add up all the numbers, then divide by how many numbers there are. https://youtu.be/x8oPXlrLMc0

	Infant mortality rate	The number of deaths of infants under one year old per 1,000 live births in a given year.
