Homework is given as part of a 3 week cycle

1. Week 1 – create flashcards
2. Week 2 – look, say, cover, write check (using the flashcards created in week 1)
3. Week 3 – Brain dump - a check to see how much you have learned

The point of the homework is to teach students how to revise effectively and to build up key vocabulary for each of their core subjects.

Here is the work per subject for this 3 week cycle

ENGLISH – Learn the following key words

Avarice	Extreme greed
Morality	Knowing the difference between right and wrong
Revolution	A revolution is a sudden change in government. It is usually violent and begins with a rebellion of the people. A very great change that leads to many other changes.

SCIENCE – Learn the following key words

Chemistry	Exothermic	A reaction which transfers energy to the surroundings.
	Combustion	An exothermic reaction between a fuel and oxygen
	Endothermic	A reaction which takes in energy from the surroundings.

MATHS – Learn the following key words

Circles	Circumference	Length around the outside of a circle. Circumference = π x diameter https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=GColEgg8E9Q
	Diameter Radius	Diameter – Distance from one edge of a circle to the other through the centre. 2 x the Radius Radius – Distance from the centre to the edge of a circle.
	Pi	π Used to work out circumference and area of circles. 3.14 when rounded to 2 decimal places.

Interesting Industry	Trans National Corporation (TNC)	A Trans National Corporation (TNC) is a large company that operates in several countries, with headquarters typically in one country and operations in others.
	Fairtrade	Trade between companies in developed countries and producers in developing countries in which fair prices are paid to the producers.
	Fairtrade premium	Extra income for farmers to spend on improving schools, hospitals or installing wells
