
YEAR 9 HOME LEARNING - CYCLE 5

The Second	Cold War	A long period of tension after World War II between the USA and its allies, and the Soviet Union and its allies. They never directly fought each other, but there was a lot of spying and competition, like in the Berlin Blockade.
